Andrejs Erglis is Professor of Medicine of the Faculty of Medicine and Director of Institute of Cardiology and Regenerative Medicine at the University of Latvia (Riga, Latvia). He is also Chief of Latvian Centre of Cardiology at Pauls Stradins Clinical University Hospital. He is currently the President of Latvian Society the Vice-President of Latvian Academy of Sciences.

He obtained his medical degree from Riga Medical Institute in 1989, the specialization in cardiology and radiology in 1990. He continued his training in interventional cardiology in USA, Australia, the Netherlands, Italy, Germany and France. In 2006 he obtained his PhD from the University of Latvia with the thesis entitled "Percutaneous coronary interventions for complex coronary lesions. The challenge of restenosis". Currently he is Leading Researcher at University of Latvia, Institute of Cardiology and Regenerative Medicine.

Since 2005 he is President of Latvian Society of Cardiology. He is a fellow of the American College of Cardiology and the European Society of Cardiology.

He is a principal investigator and a member of the Steering Committees in several international multicentre trials. He is the author or co-author of more than 400 peer-reviewed articles. has presented over 700 lectures/chairmanships at national and mostly international meetings. His major fields of scientific interest are interventional cardiology (cutting balloon interventions, left main interventions, complex lesion interventions, percutaneous treatment of structural heart disease), regenerative medicine and epidemiology of cardiovascular disease.
