

Prof. Przemyslaw Sikora

Poland

Przemysław Sikora is a graduate of the Medical University of Lublin, Poland. Since the beginning of his career, he has been working in the Department of Pediatric Nephrology at the Medical University of Lublin, and since 2016 he has been the head of this unit. He is a specialist in pediatric nephrology, nephrology and pediatrics. From 1994 to 1995, he received training in pediatric nephrology at the Hannover Medical School, Germany. His research interests are mainly in the field of urolithiasis, nephrocalcinosis, primary tubulopathies and rare metabolic diseases, including nephropathic cystinosis and primary hyperoxaluria.

In line with these interests, in 2001-2002 as a research fellow he carried out a NATO grant at the University of Cologne Medical Center, Germany on the involvement of oxalate in the pathomechanism of urolithiasis. Since then, he has been a member of European Hyperoxaluria Consortium OXALEUROPE and has collaborated with many foreign centers, mainly in Germany. In 2016-2019 he was a partner in the implementation of the EU grant ERA-NET-E-Rare-3/I/ERAdiactPH "Understanding primary hyperoxaluria type 1 towards the development of innovative therapeutic strategies" He is a co-founder and coordinator of the Polish registry of inherited tubulopathies POLTUBE. He has authored and co-authored 170 scientific publications and chapters in textbooks.
